The following copy was taken from an original statement by the grandmother of Charles Eldridge Vredenburgh [Amy Anjean Chase Vredenburgh] in her own handwriting. The copy is made as the original was written with pencil insertions (here in brackets). In September 1937 the above Charles E. Vredenburgh was residing at 1335 E. 13<sup>th</sup> St. San Pedro California. (He is a dentist by profession.) The statement regarding his family was made on paper of the size indicated [5 x 8 inches]
